Key: Governors are required to declare:

Business Interests = Declare any directorship/partnership/employment with any businesses providing goods or services to the school/trust. Also, declare any trusteeship/governorship at other educational institutions or charities, regardless of whether there is a trading relationship with the school/academy.

Personal Interests = Declare any 'connected persons', which include a spouse/unmarried civil partner/children/siblings/grandchildren/ grandparents or businesses where a 'connected person' is a director/partner/shareholder/employee/volunteer which could be seen to prevent the trustee/governor from making a decision in the best interests of the school. A conflict of interest is any situation in which a trustee/governor's personal interests or loyalties to another person or organisation could be seen to prevent a decision being made in the best interests of the school/academy.

NB: It is the responsibility of individual governors/trustees to inform the relevant person at the school/academy of any changes in their business or personal interests so this grid can be amended accordingly and dated. **If in doubt, declare!**
